

Southport High School CyberCards Robotics Policy



In order to establish a clear policy of expectations and benefits for earning a varsity letter in Robotics, the following guidelines have been put into effect. Team members can select a level of participation at which they feel comfortable. Please note that the list below is a set of <u>minimum</u> requirements. Students will also be evaluated based upon their leadership, ingenuity, teamwork, and willingness to volunteer for the benefit of the team.

Varsity Team Member

Benefits:

- 1) Evaluated for travel to National Competition
- 2) Evaluated for travel to Regional Competitions
- 3) Evaluated for travel to off-season events
- 4) Eligible to apply for all FIRST Scholarships, Awards and Contests
- 5) Eligible for Team Captain or other Group Leadership Positions
- 6) Eligible for Driver, Operator or Head Coach booth positions
- 7) Eligible to receive Sponsor or FIRST supplied items
- 8) Eligible to receive School Academic Letter

Expectations:

- 1) Completion of all assigned tasks
- 2) Maintain consistent 80% meeting attendance over the course of the year
- 3) Full attendance for all competitions and workshops
- 4) Attendance at all mandatory meetings including the FIRST Season Kick-Off
- 5) Full participation and attendance the week before and the week of any competition
- 6) Timely response to all email and action requests
- 7) Acquisition of \$500 in sponsorships or its equivalent for the Robotics Team
- 8) Documentation of 10 hours of community service
- 9) Three or more years of participation in CyberCards Robotics

Junior Varsity Team Member

Benefits:

- 1) Evaluated for travel to Regional Competitions
- 2) Evaluated for travel to off-season events
- 3) Eligible for Human Player and Assistant booth positions
- 4) Eligible to apply for <u>most</u> FIRST Scholarships, Awards and Contests
- 5) Eligible to receive Sponsor or FIRST supplied items dependent upon availability

Expectations:

- 1) Completion of all assigned tasks
- 2) Maintain consistent 60% meeting attendance over the course of the year
- 3) Full attendance for all assigned competitions
- 4) Attendance at all <u>mandatory</u> meetings including the FIRST Season Kick-Off
- 5) Full participation and attendance the week before and the week of any competition
- 6) Timely response to all email and action requests
- 7) Documentation of 5 hours of community service

Meeting Attendance Policy

All <u>regular</u> meetings will begin promptly at 2:30 PM and end at approximately 3:30 unless otherwise stated. Students arriving excessively late or leaving excessively early will not receive credit for that meeting. No differentiation will be made between an excused or unexcused meeting absence and such excuse records will not be kept. Meeting duration may be extended for some members during the building season and competition season.

Team Participation Level Selection

The purpose of this section is to acknowledge a clear understanding of the team members declared participation status. A student's status can be changed in either direction with prior coach approval. No changes in participation status will be granted after National Kick-Off Weekend.
