

Guidelines For Off-Season Events

Occurring After April 22, 2023

FIRST® is a global robotics community that prepares young people for the future.







Off-Season Events

The Basics:

- Events occurring on or after April 22nd, 2023, will be labelled as an "Off-Season" event and will be available to Event Organizers in the FIRST Tech Challenge Scoring System (ftc-scoring cloud and ftc-live).
- Off-Season events will not be officially supported by FIRST.
- Off-Season events can be requested through the Off-Season Event Notice Smartsheet.
- Off-Season events can be requested through the *FIRST* Tech Challenge Scoring System by a Program Delivery Partner.

The Details:

- Volunteers will not have access to screening or training during the off-season.
- Event Organizers will not have event level access to VMS screening, training, or placement of volunteers in roles for Off-Season events.

Teams

The Basics:

- Teams that are eligible for the *FIRST* Tech Challenge 2023-2024 season can participate in events after the new season begins on September 9, 2023.
- Teams that register for FIRST Tech Challenge before April 22, 2023, are eligible to participate in Off-Season events during the 2023 summertime frame.

The Details:

- The FIRST Tech Challenge Scoring System pulls eligible 2022-2023 season teams through a FIRST Database data call via API. The data from these calls resides in the Scoring System cloud.
- Once team 2023-2024 data is updated to the cloud by the rollover date, May 7, the team's eligibility status can no longer be updated.
 - Event Organizers pull the eligible teams for their region from the scoring system.
 - Event Organizers can add individual eligible teams from regions outside of their own.

Volunteers

The Basics:

 Volunteers who register for your event will show up in the FIRST Tech Challenge Scoring System if they are added to and screened through VMS before the May 7 rollover date.

The Details:

- A subset of volunteers will require screening, based on the date of their screening expiration (this is normal and happens every season).
- The scoring system pulls this information from the *FIRST* database via an API. Volunteers must apply for their event roles before May 7th, 2023.





Program Delivery Partners/ Event Organizers

The Basics:

- Teams registered by April 22, 2023, will populate correctly.
- Volunteers registered by May 7, 2023, will populate correctly.
- Off-season events can be requested via Off-Season Event Notice Smartsheet.
- Events added during the Off-Season will appear on the *FIRST* Tech Challenge Scoring system but will **not be added** to the *FIRST* event database.
- Event results will populate to FTC Event Web: Home (firstinspires.org)
- Last Official Event Date for 2022-2023: April 22, 2023.
- Last Off-Season Event Date: September 8, 2023.

The Details:

- Events added to the FIRST Database must follow all <u>FIRST Tech Challenge Event</u> Guidelines.
- Off-Season events will not be added to the FIRST event database, only to the FIRST Tech Challenge Scoring System.
- The FIRST Tech Challenge Scoring System cannot be modified to accommodate Off-Season events. <u>The FIRST Tech Challenge Live</u> release should be used for Off-Season events.
