

SAFETY GLASS STATION GUIDELINES

- Everyone in the pit, playing field and practice field must wear safety glasses at all times. Side shields are also acceptable.
 - Teams provide their own
 - *FIRST*® provides safety glasses for visitors and guests
- Each person's eyes must be clearly visible to others:
 - Lightly tinted lenses are approved (such as yellow, rose, blue and amber)
 - Accommodations will be made for participants that require tinted safety glasses
 - Safety glasses and side shields must be ANSI-approved, UL-Listed, CE EN166 rated, AS/NZS certified, or CSA rated
 - Reflective lenses are prohibited

Supplies packed by *FIRST*

Each event will have several totes (labelled specifically for that event) with the following items:

- **Adult and Oversized Safety Glasses**
- **Children's Safety Glasses**
- **Cleaning Supplies**
- **Ear Plugs:** used ear plugs DO NOT need to be returned
- **Event Paperwork:** paperwork needed to manage safety supplies.
- **Pens, red markers, and clip boards:** please ensure these are returned to *FIRST*



Helpful Tips

- Ensure the safety glass tables are always adequately stocked with safety glasses and ear plugs
 - Mark all glasses before loaning them out
 - Retrieve borrowed glasses as people leave
- Safety glasses are to be borrowed on a daily basis – consider using the Safety Glasses Sign Out Sheet to track them.
- If your event is collecting glasses back, be sure to clean them between uses with the supplies provided by HQ
- If you run low on supplies, you may use totes from events that have already occurred. PLEASE check with your event management before taking out used glasses from a prior event. For example, if you are at a Week 3 Regional event, you may check the totes from Week 1 or Week 2. **Please do not take supplies from events occurring after yours.** If you do, please notify mmalinak@firstinspires.org
- Totes and supplies should be loaded back onto the truck for the next event
