

## Kenzie Academy FIRST<sup>®</sup> Scholarship

Kenzie Academy's accelerated training programs give you the skills you need to get the job you want. Kenzie offers 2-year programs in Software Engineering, User Experience (UX) Engineering, and Digital Marketing, combined with apprenticeship opportunities, offering students an alternative to traditional colleges. Students have the option of attending the program in person at Kenzie's downtown campus in Indianapolis or online.

Kenzie Academy's instructors are seasoned tech experts, including a Stanford University Computer Science Graduate and engineering manager, a Google and LinkedIn UX Designer, and a senior marketer from Zillow.com. Students work with mentors from tech giants like Facebook, Google, and Instagram.

At Kenzie Academy, you won't be sitting in a lecture hall. Instead, you'll be completing hands-on training through our flipped classroom and project-based learning model. You'll showcase your skills—and build your resume—through demo days and capstone projects.

In support of the FIRST mission, Kenzie Academy is offering ten, \$12,000 tuition scholarships for FIRST participants and alumni. Tuition for all two-year programs is \$24,000.

## **Scholarship Details**

- This is our highest and most prestigious scholarship awarded
- Ten, non-renewable scholarships awarded each year
- Award Amount: \$12,000
- May be applied to any 2019 cohort: January, April, July, or September
- After winning a scholarship from Kenzie, FIRST Scholarship winners will only be responsible for an additional \$12,000 for training, which can be financed via cash or an Income Share Agreement (ISA). If a student uses an ISA, they will only be required to pay \$100 upfront.

## Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, you must:

- Have participated on a FIRST<sup>®</sup> Robotics Competition (FRC<sup>®</sup>) or a FIRST<sup>®</sup> Tech Challenge (FTC<sup>®</sup>) Team during high school between 2010-2019.
- Complete a Campus Tour OR Attend an Open House at Kenzie Academy.
- Apply to Kenzie Academy at <a href="http://kenzie.academy/apply">http://kenzie.academy/apply</a> for the April, July, or September 2019 program
- Be Accepted to Kenzie Academy
- Be authorized to work in the United States

- A video recommendation (2-minute max) from an adult mentor/coach on your FIRST team
- A personal video (2-minute max) OR essay describing (500-word max):
