Scholarship Description

Four-year scholarships that range from \$6,000 to \$20,000. The scholarship amount is based primarily on academic merit.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be admitted as a new freshman to one of eight undergraduate majors offered by the UWM College of Engineering & Applied Science.
- Have participated at least one full season during your junior or senior year on a *FIRST* Robotics Competition (FRC) or *FIRST* Tech Challenge (FTC) Team.
- File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Application Requirements

- Complete the application for admission to UWM no later than March 1.
- Send a letter of recommendation from a coach of your *FIRST* team. Please send the recommendation letter by March 1 to:
